Hunt Information:

- Each hunt consists of 2 days, Saturday and Sunday.
- A mandatory orientation will be conducted at 3:30 on the Friday before your hunt.
- One permit will be drawn for each hunt period.
- Each successful applicant will be permitted to bring one hunting partner.
- Only non-lead ammo will be allowed.
- One dog will be allowed per hunter.
- Hunt area is walk-in only, no blinds.
- Period 1: **December 7-8** (the application deadline is November 20)
- Period 2: **December 14-15** (the application deadline is November 27)
- Period 3: **January 4-5** (the application deadline is December 18)
- Period 4: **January 18-19** (the application deadline is January 1)
- Period 5: **January 25-26** (the application deadline is January 8)
