

Spilled Boat Fuel is NOT "Just a Drop in the Water"



California has more than 1 million boaters.

It's easy to protect California's ecosystem and still have fun!
Follow these tips to prevent spilling oil into the state's waterways:

💧 Hold the fuel dispenser upright, so it doesn't drip onto the dock, your boat, or into the water.



💧 Know your fuel tank's capacity; Subtract 5% for expansion- that's a "full tank."

💧 Use an absorbent cloth to wipe up any drips or spills.



💧 Never use detergent to disperse spilled oil. Detergents can harm the ecosystem.



💧 Never let fuel flow from your boat's air vent.
