Congratulations! You have been selected for the May Chimineas Family Pig hunt. This hunt may be cancelled or rescheduled if roads become unsafe due to rain.

This hunt will be on the Northern portion of the Chimineas Unit. The check is located off of Soda Lake Road on the Carrizo Plains. Please see the attached map and directions included with this letter. You will need to register and get a free permit each morning prior to your hunt. You will also need to check out at the end of each day. Water and toilet facilities are not available.

The terrain is highly variable with rolling hills and steep canyons. The access roads are all dirt and while a 4-wheel drive vehicle is not necessary, a vehicle with good clearance is highly recommended. You can review the hunt area by checking out interactive map website at http://www.dfg.ca.gov/lands/viewer/index.html. The ecological reserve is located in southeastern San Luis Obispo County. There is no camping on the Chimineas Unit. However, camping is available on the Carrizo Plain National Monument and the Los Padres National Forest. The nearest gas station is approximately 50 miles away in either Santa Maria (west at Highway 101) or Maricopa (east at Highway 33) so make sure to fill your tank prior to getting out to the hunt. You may only hunt quail, dove, wild pigs, and rabbits during this hunt. Hunting for all other species is prohibited on the ecological reserve.

As of July 1, 2009, regulations prohibit the use of lead ammunition for hunting big game within the range of the California condor, which includes the Chimineas Unit. Therefore, the use of lead free ammunition for hunting pigs is required during this hunt.

Some of the properties to the east and west of the South Chimineas Unit are privately owned. Access to this private property is prohibited. All vehicle access is restricted to existing roads. 
The Ten Commandments of Firearms Safety:

- 1. Watch that muzzle! Keep it pointed in a safe direction at all times.
 - 2. Treat every firearm with the respect due a loaded gun.

 - 5. Check your barrel and ammunition.
 - 6. Unload firearms when not in use.
 - 7. Point your firearm only at something you intend to shoot.
 - 8. Don't run, jump, or climb with a loaded firearm.
 - 9. Store firearms and ammunition separately and safely.
- 10. Don't drink alcohol, use drugs or take medications that might impair your abilities and good judgment before or while handling firearms or archery equipment.



Directions to Chimineas Unit – Northern Entrance

- 1. Take Highway 58 to Soda Lake Road. Soda Lake Road is approximately 50 miles east of Highway 101 in Atascadero or 50 miles west of Interstate 5 at Button Willow. Turn south on Soda Lake Road.
- 2. Go south approximately 7.7 miles on Soda Lake Road until you reach the Carrizo Plains National Monument boundary. There will be a major power line that crosses the road immediately south of the turn off.
- 3. Turn right (south) onto the dirt road (Sprague Hill Road) at this location and proceed approximately 5.5 miles until you reach the main entrance gate and check in station for the north Chimineas Unit.
