

Gear Definitions	"Troll line" FGC §9025.5(b), §9028: A line with one or more hooks towed by a vessel underway and making way. Troll lines and handlines more than 900 feet in length are not permitted unless they are used as set lines.  "Set line" FGC §8601, §8601.5(a): Any line used to take fish that is anchored to the bottom on each end and is not free to drift with the tide or current is a set line. Set lines shall be marked at both ends with buoys displaying above their waterlines, in numerals at least 2 in. high, the fisherman's identification number. It is unlawful to use set lines with hooks more than 100 feet above the anchor or ocean bottom.
Minimum Size Limit	FGC §8392: 22 in. total length. It is permissible to swing or fan the tail.
Season	FGC §8391: Open year-round.
Take Limit	None
FGC §7856(f)	Sturgeon or striped bass shall not be possessed aboard a commercial fishing vessel.
