**Phase One:** *Kelp, Adopted in 2014*

**Phase Two:** *Edible seaweed, agar-bearing, and kelp*

- Broad overhaul
- Management strategies

**Phase Three:** *Edible seaweed, agar-bearing, and kelp*

- License fees and royalty rates

# Potential Regulatory Changes and Challenges

- 1. Regulatory language cleanup and consistency**
- 2. Revise the Commercial Kelp Harvest License**
- 3. Consider harvest methods, limits, and seasons**

## **Challenges:**

- Staff resources and capacity
- Recent kelp loss and recovery efforts

- **Dec 2019:** Commission Notice Hearing
