ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Effective July 1, 2019, nonlead ammunition is required when taking any wildlife with a firearm anywhere in California. Please plan accordingly.

**YOU MUST SIGN ALL WAIVERS BEFORE YOU ARE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE!
***PLEASE PRINT OUT ENOUGH NECESSARY WAIVERS FOR YOUR GROUP.

ALL Hunters must possess a valid California hunting license and upland game bird validation. Hunters possessing a junior hunting license do not need an upland game bird validation. They must be accompanied by a non-shooting adult 18 years of age or older. All shooters and non-shooters must wear shooting safety glasses, and wear "some" blaze orange. All necessary waivers must be signed prior to being allowed to participate.

Please come prepared and wear appropriate gear for the hunt; we strongly recommend you bring water, a hat, sturdy shoes/boots, sweater/jacket, mosquito repellant and a cooler with ice for your birds. For safety, junior hunters must have a properly fitted shotgun. Please note if you are not prepared for the hunt or your gear is deemed unsafe you may be asked to withdraw from the hunt.

- ** YOU MUST BE THERE ON TIME! **Check in time is 7:30 AM. Check-in is mandatory.
- ** IF YOU ARE MORE THAN 30 MINUNTES LATE FOR CHECK-IN, WITHOUT NOTIFICATION, YOUR SPOT MAY BE FILLED BY ANOTHER HUNTER.
- **IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS HUNT, YOU MUST NOTIFY NICK BECHTEL WITHIN 48 HOURS AT (562)254-8969. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY MAKE YOU INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN NEXT SEASON'S HUNTS.
- **NOTE: IF YOU OR ANY OF YOUR GUEST HUNTERS ARE IN NEED OF SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS DUE TO A DISABILITY, IT IS NECESSARY TO CONTACT ME NO LESS THAN 7 DAYS IN ADVANCE OF THE HUNT DATE.

HUNTING DOGS

You may bring your own hunting dog, but you are required to obey hunter etiquette and maintain control of your dog at all times in the field. If your dog does not remain in your control, you will be asked to leave your dog in your vehicle. This is not a training opportunity for dogs.

The Upland Game Bird Special Hunt Program is pleased to offer you this opportunity. Practice good sportsmanship, enjoy your hunt and most of all, be a safe hunter.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING SPECIAL HUNTS AND JUNIOR HUNTERS

NONLEAD AMMUNITION ONLY!

Each participant must provide the following:

- All Junior hunters must be accompanied by a Non-Hunting Adult
- A valid hunting license/upland game bird validation. (Junior hunters are not required to possess an upland game bird validation).
- Hunters are required to wear shooting safety glasses with an ANSI rating of Z87.1 or above and all participants in the hunting field MUST wear shooting safety glasses. Glasses will be available for loan.
- Appropriate hunting attire including thick jeans to ward off the vegetation.
- A blaze orange hunting vest or similar safety apparel is required for all person's in the field. If the hunter does not bring one, an orange vest will be provided.
- The hunt will be held rain or shine, so please be prepared.
- Junior hunters may have only TWO shot shells in the magazine or chamber while hunting.
- Bring your own food and drinks, and water for your dog.
- A good attitude and willingness to participate and follow instructions.



Traveling from I-15, take the **Temecula Parkway/ CA HWY 79 South**. Drive approximately 25 miles. Entrance to **CDFW Oak** Grove **Property** will be 1.7 miles on the <u>left</u> past the Cleveland National Forest **Oak Grove Campground**. Signs will be posted for entrance to CDFW Oak Grove Property. Traveling on CA HWY 79 North from **Warner Springs** it is approximately 12 miles to the entrance of **CDFW Oak** Grove **Property located on the Right**, Signs will be posted. A CDFW vehicle will be parked at the front to direct participating hunters on to the Check-in area.

The Ten Commandments of Firearms Safety:

- 1. Watch that muzzle! Keep it pointed in a safe direction at all times.
 - 2. Treat every firearm with the respect due a loaded gun.
- 3. Be sure of your target and what is in front of it and beyond it.
- 4. Keep your finger outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot .
 - 5. Check your barrel and ammunition.
 - 6. Unload firearms when not in use.
 - 7. Point your firearm only at something you intend to shoot.
 - 8. Don't run, jump, or climb with a loaded firearm.
 - 9. Store firearms and ammunition separately and safely.
- 10. Don't drink alcohol, use drugs or take medications that might impair your abilities and good judgment before or while handling firearms or archery equipment.
