Hunters must possess a valid 2019-2020 California hunting license and upland game bird stamp. Hunters possessing a junior hunting license do not need an upland game bird stamp and must be accompanied by a non-shooting adult 18 years of age or older. All shooters and non-shooters must wear shooting safety glasses, blaze orange, initial and sign the enclosed waiver. **ONLY FEDERALLY APPROVED NON-TOXIC SHOT MAY BE USED ON STATE LANDS** 

Please come prepared and wear appropriate gear for the hunt; we strongly recommend you bring water, a hat, sturdy shoes/boots, sweater/jacket, mosquito repellant and a cooler with ice for your birds. For safety, Apprentice hunters must have a properly fitted shotgun. Please note if you are not prepared for the hunt or your gear is deemed unsafe you may be asked to withdraw from the hunt.

The Upland Game Bird Special Hunts Program is pleased to offer you this special hunt. Practice good sportsmanship, enjoy your hunt and most of all, be a safe hunter.

## **Hunt Information Sheet for Yolo Bypass Apprentice Hunts**

#### ONLY FEDERALLY APPROVED NON-TOXIC SHOT MAY BE USED ON STATE LANDS

Hunters must register at the check station prior to hunting and must return to the check station and turn in permits before leaving.

All successful applicants wishing to hunt must report to the hunter check station prior to 7:30 a.m.

The use of BLAZE ORANGE vests and/or hats and SHOOTING GLASSES is REQUIRED for all hunters entering the field. HEARING PROTECTION is encouraged.

Vegetation within portions of the hunt area is heavy so dress appropriately.

Junior hunters must be supervised by an adult (must be 18 years or older); one adult may

supervise no more than two junior hunters.

Hunting is limited to male pheasants only. No rabbit hunting.

No smoking or fires will be permitted on these State lands.

The use of trained dogs is allowed but they must be under the control of the owner at

all times. Dogs should remain on a leash when in the parking area.

Portable toilet facilities will be provided.

All state and federal hunting regulations apply.


Junior hunters are not required to possess an Upland Game Bird Stamp.

NO LITTERING - Please remove spent shotshells and refuse from hunting areas.

The Department is hereby authorized to refuse to issue a permit to anyone and to revoke any permit and to eject the holder forthwith from the area for disorderly conduct, intoxication, or for any other reason when it appears that the general safety or welfare of the area, or persons thereon, is endangered. Decision of the employee of the Department in charge of the area in such respect shall be final.

#### Yolo Wildlife Area Check Station

From I-80 eastbound exit on East Chiles Road, turn left on County Road 32B/East Chiles Road. Proceed to the Yolo Bypass levee and enter the Wildlife Area. From I-80 westbound, exit on East Chiles Road/County Road 32A exit (first exit west of the Causeway), turn right at stop sign. Follow this road under the freeway and turn left onto the levee and enter the Wildlife Area. Proceed south for two miles to the hunter check station at the bottom of the auto tour route.



## The Ten Commandments of Firearms Safety:

- 1. Watch that muzzle! Keep it pointed in a safe direction at all times.
  - 2. Treat every firearm with the respect due a loaded gun.
- 3. Be sure of your target and what is in front of it and beyond it.
- 4. Keep your finger outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot.
  - 5. Check your barrel and ammunition.
  - 6. Unload firearms when not in use.
  - 7. Point your firearm only at something you intend to shoot.
    - 8. Don't run, jump, or climb with a loaded firearm.
    - 9. Store firearms and ammunition separately and safely.
- 10. Don't drink alcohol, use drugs or take medications that might impair your abilities and good judgment before or while handling firearms or archery equipment.

Waiver And Release Of Claims: I hereby expressly waive any right that I might have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for any physical or emotional injuries, illnesses, death or other damages that I might suffer as a result of participating in hunting activities on State property.
5. Waiver And Release Of Claims Based On Negligence: In addition to the inherent dangers involved in hunting or State property described above, I further acknowledge that serious injuries or death may be caused by the negligent acts of State employees, its agents, volunteers or other persons which increase the risk of injury beyond those normally anticipated while hunting. I hereby expressly agree to assume the risk that I may be seriously injured or killed through the negligent acts of others. I agree to waive any right I may have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for injuries or death that I may suffer arising out of participating in hunting or related activities including physical or emotional injuries, illnesses or death caused by the negligent acts of the State, its agents, employees, volunteers or other persons.
Prior to executing this waiver and release of liability, I was given the opportunity to thoroughly read the entire document and to consult my own legal counsel regarding the potential effect of signing this agreement. I hereby consent to be bound by its terms and conditions.
