The following are the critical functions with pertinent updates for HRB.

EMERGENCY CORONAVIRUS WORKERS' COMPESATION CLAIMS:

1. Department of Human Resources Guidance: COVID-19 claims do not have a particular special status; the overall rules for administration and benefits are the same for these claims as they are for any other. State Fund will evaluate each one on a case-by-case basis to determine if the necessary legal requirements for compensability have been met. If you have an employee that wants to file a claim for COVID-19, please be sure to include the specific route of exposure if known or as stated by the employee. If you have specific knowledge of heightened nonindustrial risk, such as recent travel to heavily affected regions for example, then that should be noted as well. Lastly, if you have questions regarding quarantine policies for affected employees, your HR office's designated liaison should contact CalHR's Personnel Services Bureau (PSB).
