PIPELINE SPILL UPDATE #5

SUISUN CITY, Calif. – The Kinder Morgan Energy Partners (KMP) Concord to Sacramento pipeline resumed normal operations as of 2:30 p.m. PDT Sunday, May 2. Representatives from the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) and California State Fire Marshal monitored the pipeline pressure test of the Concord to Sacramento pipeline following the installation of the new 50-foot long replacement section and approved the pipeline for operation. California Dept. of Fish and Game Office of Spill Prevention and Response (OSPR), United States Coast Guard (USCG), KMP, and contracted oil spill response professionals continue cleanup efforts. OSPR continues to monitor impacted wildlife in the affected area.
