


34° 00' 34" N x 118° 31' 47" W Depth 60 ft. (MLLW) 295° (mag), 4.5 N miles from Marina Del Rey entrance 1961 (Augumented 1971) Area 0.5 acres 330 tons quarry rock, 44 concrete shelters, 4 car bodies, 1 streetcar.

An original "replication reef". Automobiles and streetcar have disintegrated. Augmented with 100 tons of pier pilings in 1971. Some sandbass in fall. Occasional good sculpin bites in spring.
