SUMMARY (for JIC use):

57 live oiled birds (42 brown pelicans, 5 common murres, 3 common loons, and 7 other bird species) have been admitted to the facility and 186 birds have been collected dead. 59 marine mammals (52 California sea lions, 6 Northern elephant seals, 1 harbor seal) were recovered alive, and 95 dead marine mammals (15 dolphins, 71 CA sea lions, 1 elephant seal, 8 unidentified mammals) have also been collected. Of the live captured animals, thirty-one (31) marine mammals and eleven (11) birds have died after recovery, and seventeen (17) birds have been successfully released.
