Samaritan Log-In Instructions

Log in at https://ec.volunteernow.com/custom/1398

On a smart phone, drop the https:// and just start with ec.volunteer...

Username: First initial of first name(as it is on your instructor card), full last name and 4 digit HEI#. If your HEI# is 157, then enter 0157. For example **sbrar9999** Password: **pass1234**

Dash Board: Home page of your volunteer profile

Edit Profile: Change your address, phone number, etc.

Search Opportunities: See what other volunteer opportunities are available with CDFW

My Placements: Shows what volunteer opportunities you are signed up for My Schedule: Calendar of other opportunities you are signed up for, will not show Hunter Ed

Report Hours: This is where you will log your hours just like the instructor scantron

Log Book: Will show hours you have submitted and have been approved To Report hours:

Select a survey, for example the 2015 Hunter Education Classes survey. Fill out survey just like you would the instructor scantron and click OK. The log book entry will show up in your log book. You may click the check box and edit or delete the entry until the Lt. approves it. Once it is approved, you will not be able to make any edits to it.

Please update your personal information making sure it is all correct. Make sure you include an e-mail address.

Once you are logged in to Samaritan click on the "REPORT HOURS" tab and then click on the 2015 Correspondence course. Answer the questions.
