# Putah Creek Wildlife Area Reopens for Public Use

JULY 8, 2016

The Putah Creek Wildlife Area in Solano County will open for public use starting July 9, 2016. The Wildlife Area was closed to allow recovery from the 2015 Wragg Fire. The area is recovering from the after effects of the fire and winter rains and slopes are stable enough to allow safe public access without incurring environmental damage.

The hiking public is advised to choose their footing carefully and exercise caution as portions of the existing trails may have undergone shifting of underlying surfaces and fallen trees may still be present. As always, avoid hiking in extreme heat, wear appropriate footwear and bring plenty of water.

Putah Creek Wildlife Area is located in Solano County just east of Lake Berryessa.
