

REVISED PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD AGREEMENTS

Pursuant to the Call for Applications for the Auction or Sale of Big Game Fund-raising License Tags for the 2019-20 Hunting Season

Following the Intent to Award posted on October 22, 2018, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife has re-evaluated and reviewed for responsiveness to the Call for Applications due to the availability of one additional fund-raising tag and proposes to award agreements for the auction or sale of big game fund-raising license tags to the organizations listed below. At this time, it is anticipated that 2 bighorn sheep, 2 elk, 1 pronghorn antelope, and 8 deer tags will be awarded. All fund-raising license tags will be available contingent upon adoption of regulations authorizing such tags.
