

# PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD AGREEMENTS

## Pursuant to the Call for Applications for the Auction or Sale of Big Game Fund-raising License Tags for the 2022-23 Hunting Season

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) posted a Call for Applications on October 22, 2021, for up to 18 tags. Following the bid opening on November 15, 2021, an evaluation and review for responsiveness to the Call for Applications resulted in the Department proposal to award agreements to 13 organizations. The remaining 5 tags were captured in a second solicitation posted on December 1, 2021. Following the bid opening on December 15, 2021, an evaluation and review for responsiveness to the Call for Applications has resulted in the Department proposal to award agreements for the auction or sale of big game fund-raising license tags to the 5 organizations listed below. At this time, it is anticipated that the remaining 5 big game fundraising tags will be awarded, including 1 bighorn sheep tag, 1 elk tag, 1 pronghorn tag, and 2 deer tags.

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## Pursuant to the Call for Applications for the Auction or Sale of Big Game Fund-raising License Tags for the 2022-23 Hunting Season

Following the bid opening on November 15, 2021, and evaluation and review for responsiveness to the Call for Applications, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife proposes to award agreements for the auction or sale of big game fund-raising license tags to the organizations listed below.
