QUARTERLY PROGRESS REPORT

Project Name: Multiple Data Source Approach to Monitoring and Management of Mule Deer: application in Deer Zones X9a and X9b (Mono and Inyo Counties)

Quarter: Time Period: July - September 2014

Work Performed: July fixed-wing flight for location of GPS collars didn't occur because DFW Air Services was not available. 1 August 2014 California Deer Association approved funding in the amount of \$13,500 for 50 hours of fixed-wing time. Mr. Geoff Pope, Black Mountain Air, in Bishop, CA will be used. CDA funds will be used when DFW Air Services is not available. In August, 12.5 hours of fixed wing time were billed to CDA. This flight was to collect summer range locations and survival of each deer. The flight in September for GPS collars didn't occur because Air Services couldn't fly and the local pilot was too busy, with short notice. The 9 GPS collars need to be monitored monthly. As of August 7th, there are 26 marked deer in Casa Diablo, 28 marked in Goodale, and 24 marked in Round Valley, out of a total of 30 originally collared in each of the three herds.

With the support of LMAC Work Code: NC 8001-26; BGMA Fund#0200.33, a ground survey study plan is in draft. In this plan we propose to evaluate whether there are differences in age and sex ratios when classification counts are done from roads (currently) versus randomly determined routes. Besides staff time, there is little to no cost for the study, though LMAC project has budgeted \$600 for ground surveys.

Work Anticipated for Next Quarter: Continue to update deer database. Fixed wing flight (DFW Air Services/ local pilot) in early October, then again in November and December, will be to locate the 9 GPS collared deer. These GPS collars are automatic drop off and need to be located as soon after drop-off as possible. Radio-collars for the spring 2015 captures will be purchased in early October. Necessary update to the LMAC Budget with justification and rewriting of capture plan will occur in October and November, respectively. Ground survey random route study will be tested in December.
