

Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF)



- Proceeds from Cap-and-Trade auctions deposited in the GGRF
- The Governor and Legislature appropriate GGRF to administering agencies in the annual budget



Use of GGRF



- Agencies with GGRF appropriation must use the money to invest in projects that:
 - Reduce greenhouse gases (GHGs)
 - Further the purposes of AB 32

California Climate Investments

- Air Resources Board is responsible for providing guidance to agencies administering California Climate Investments:
 - General guidance
 - Developing Quantification Methodologies
 - Investments to benefit Disadvantaged Communities
 - Reporting requirements



Wetlands Restoration for Greenhouse **Gas Reduction Grant Program**



Department of Fish and Wildlife

- Budget Act of 2014 (~\$25 million to CDFW)
 - Wetlands Restoration for Greenhouse Gas Reduction Grant Program
 - ✓ Contribute to the implementation of AB 32 and the CWAP
- Focus reduce GHGs and provide co-benefits through restoration or enhancement of:
 - Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta wetlands
 - **Coastal wetlands**
 - Mountain meadow ecosystems



FY 2014-2015 Grant Cycle
















Prop1 – Two Grant Programs


Department of Fish & Wildlife \$372.5 million

- \$285,000,000 Watershed Restoration Grant Program
 - Statewide watershed protection and restoration outside of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta


- \$87,500,000 <u>Delta Water Quality and Ecosystem Restoration</u> <u>Grant Program</u>
 - Water quality, ecosystem restoration, and fish protection facilities that benefit the Delta




