Meet with sponsor	As soon as possible	
Rainbow Trout Eggs Available	End of February	
Steelhead eggs available	March - April	Limited to schools in Sonoma and Mendocino Counties
Fish hatch	1-10 days after delivery	
Release fish	No later than 8 weeks from delivery	It is recommended you release fry 5 weeks after delivery
Clean tank for storage	After release	
Return 772 permit	No later than 2 weeks after release	Submit to R3CAEP@wildlife.ca.gov Or to your sponsor Check to see if your permit was received at classroomaquarium.wordpress.com Failure to return 772 makes you ineligible to get eggs next year.
