Re: Fees for Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreements

June 13, 2016

This letter is to provide you with a 15-day continuation notice of proposed regulatory action relative to the proposed increase in fees for Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreements in Section 699.5, Title 14, California Code of Regulations. The initial public notice was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 29, 2016, Register 2016, No. 18-Z (OAL Notice File No. Z-2016-0419-08).

In response to a request from the Department of Finance (DOF), the Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has prepared an addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons (ISOR) and an amended STD Form 399, revising the estimated revenue from fees for marijuana cultivation sites requiring remediation. No changes to the proposed regulatory text were necessary.
