Satellite tags were placed on several green sturgeon this year to track their movements in the Pacific Ocean and inland waters along the West Coast. Once recovered, these tags will provide researchers with valuable information to protect this federally protected species.

Likely locations for tag retrieval: open ocean coastal portions of San Francisco and San Mateo counties, and the shores and waters of San Francisco Bay, San Pablo Bay, Suisun Bay, and the Delta.

If you see a fish with a tag attached, DO NOT REMOVE THE TAG from the fish. Instead, note the tag number and call/email the point of contact printed on the tag. THANK YOU!
