

Amended Fee Schedule for Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreements

The Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has completed a rulemaking under the Administrative Procedure Act to amend its fee schedule for lake and streambed alteration agreements (LSA; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 699.5). This action amends regulations to adjust the LSA fee schedule to pay the total costs the Department incurs to administer and enforce Fish and Game Code section 1600 et seq. The amendments include increasing the fees in the fee schedule; adding a new fee category for marijuana cultivation sites that require remediation; enabling applicants to pay fees by credit card; and other minor format and text changes. The [new fee schedule](#) will become effective on October 1, 2016. All notifications and fees received by the Department on or after October 1st must comply with the new fee schedule.
