In accordance with the Political Reform Act (Act) and Government Code section 87306, the Department of Fish and Wildlife's (CDFW) Conflict of Interest Code (Code) identifies specific classifications that require its employees to file an annual Form 700. Employees in Category II are required to file their Form 700 for calendar year 2016, on or before **April 3, 2017**. As a designated filer, officials and employees are required to disclose specific information, which may represent a potential conflict of interest.

Please file immediately. There are no provisions in the Act to extend a filing deadline. Any person who files a Form 700 after the April 3, 2017, deadline may be liable for a late fine pursuant to Government Code section 91013, of \$10 per day, for each day a statement is late up to a maximum of \$100 can be assessed. The department hereby provides notice that persons filing late Statements of Economic Interest (Form 700) will be referred to the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC).

To assist with this process, below is a link to Human Resources' Conflict of Interest information that includes, the designated classifications, disclosure requirements for Category II, Form 700 and reference pamphlet, and the Incompatible Activities Policy.

Employees must complete all required sections (1-5) of the form, in section 2 Jurisdiction of Office, check "state", section 3 Type of Statement, check "annual", and in section 4 "Schedule Summary check all applicable schedules or "none." Filers should save a copy of this statement for their record.
