2002-2003 Fiscal Year Schedule

Our work schedule this year in Wrinkle Cove consists of re-building 12 brushpiles and adding 2\* brushpiles on the west side of the cove where we worked in 93/94.

Vallecito inmates will work one day in early December on the old piles and two days in mid-January with the 5 loads of trees from Lodi, to build the 2\* new brushpiles.

Ten catfish pipes which were not installed in 2001 will be put in the rebuilt piles due to the low water level of the lake.

Kyle Murphy is the new biologist from DFG who replaces Fred Kopperdahl since his retirement last January. Kyle has surveyed our work on September 6, and is ready to oversee the work.

We are ready to proceed with the project as soon as the corps is able to provide the \$500 dollars of our \$1,700.00 budget.
