Nominations that were submitted in response to the Federal Register notice dated September 30, 2015 are still under consideration. These nominees do not need to reapply, unless they wish to make changes to their nomination package.

Prospective members of ISAC need to be senior-level professionals with expertise relevant to the prevention, eradication, and/or control of invasive species who have demonstrated a high degree of capacity for:

- *Advising individuals in leadership positions, team work, project management, tracking relevant Federal government programs and policy making procedures, and networking with and representing their peer-community of interest.*
 - *ISAC members need not be scientists. Membership from a wide range of disciplines and professional sectors is encouraged.*
 - ***At this time, we are particularly interested in applications from senior-level representatives of tribes, small businesses, non-profit and/or private sector entities focused on landscape-scale management, and organizations specializing in innovative communication strategies.***
