






Restrooms will be located in hillside adjacent to current facility.




Bute Valley Wildlife Area, Unit 8B

Shallow managed wetlands provide habitat for many species.




Upper Bute Basin Wildlife Area Howard Slough Field 205


Upper Butte Basin Wildlife Area Little Dry Creek Field 105


Gray Lodge Wildlife Area, Field 18




Los Banos Wildlife Area, Field 56






Westside Ditch on Volta Wildlife Area is main water supply for western half of the Area.










One possible location of the ADA path and fishing platform.




Fishing platform might also be located here, adjacent to Bonnyview Road bridge.






Kahala Site

Location of proposed well at Kahala.




La Cienega de Chicca Site

Existing well and pump at Cienega de Chicca need rehabilitation.







Existing deep well at Widgeon is new and working well. Proposed pipeline will follow ditch in background.
