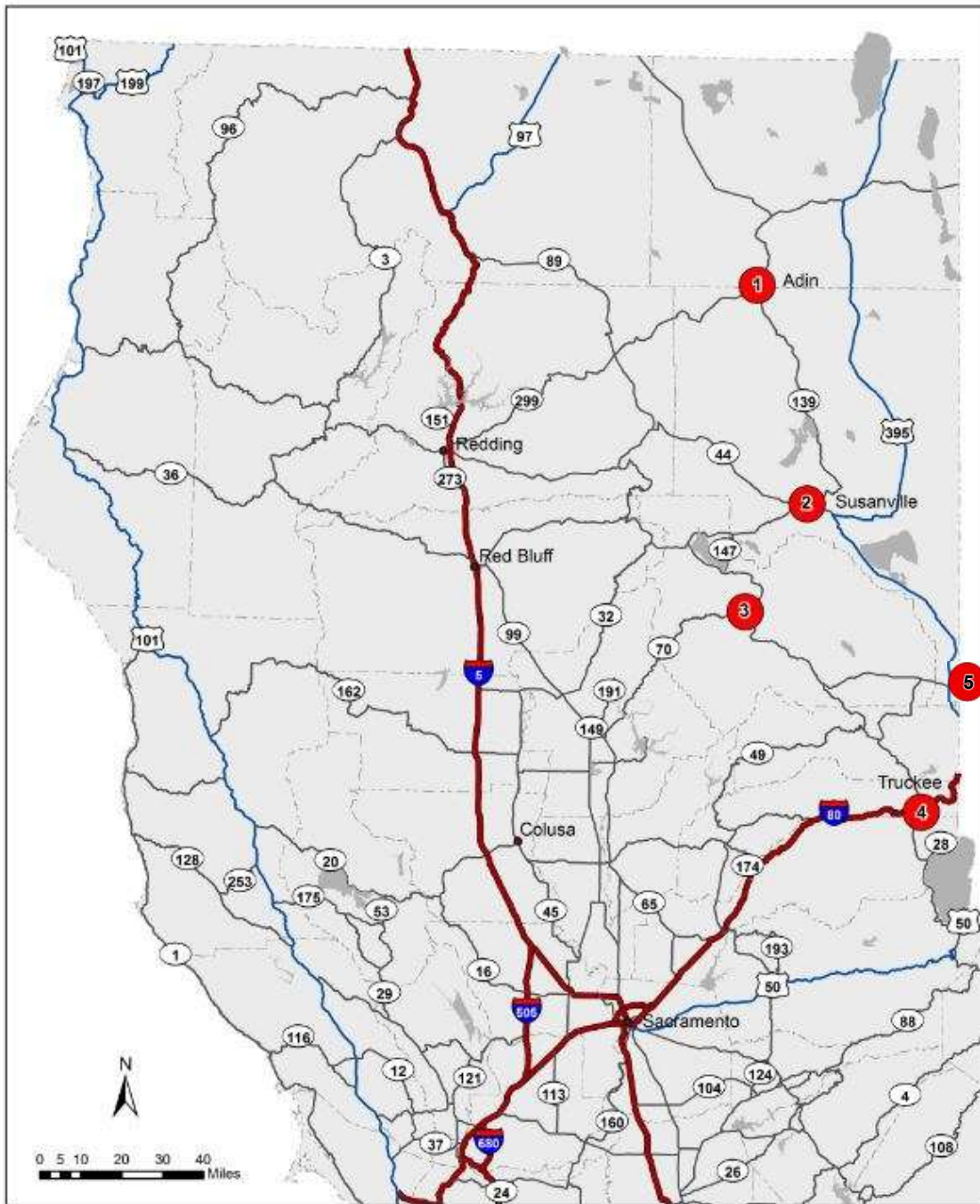


2017 Northern California Chronic Wasting Disease Surveillance Station Locations

Chronic wasting disease (CWD) is a fatal neurologic disease of deer and elk. The disease has never been found in California. The California Department of Fish and Wildlife is actively surveilling California's deer and elk for the disease and we need your help to continue and expand these efforts. We are asking hunters to voluntarily bring their harvested deer to one of five (5) CWD sampling/hunter check stations open on Saturday, October 7 and Sunday, October 8, 2017. General locations are depicted on the below map of Northern California and maps for the specific locations are on separate pages.

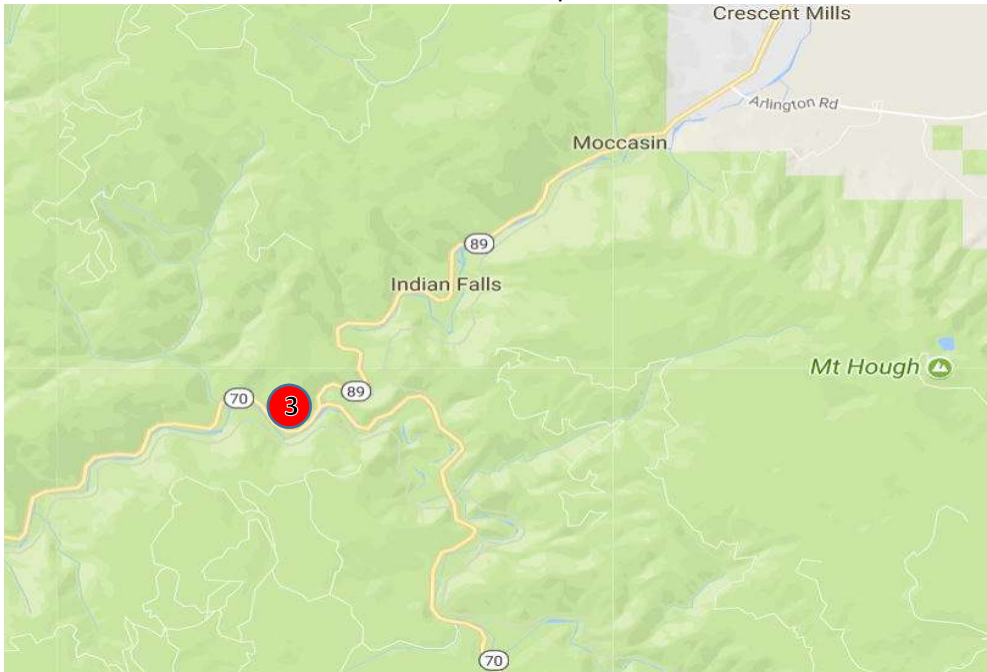
