

# AGUA FRIA MULTI-SPECIES CONSERVATION BANK

## SAN JOAQUIN KIT FOX SERVICE AREA

---

This service area is described as follows: Beginning at the northwestern boundary of Stanislaus County, the western service area boundary is described along the western county boundaries of Stanislaus, Merced, and Fresno Counties south to a line extending due east through the community of "Five Points" and eastward to a southern tributary to the San Joaquin River. The boundary extends northward along the San Joaquin River to just northeast of the community of "Vernalis" along State Highway 132. The boundary then extends westward along highway 132 to its intersection with Interstate Highway 5. It extends southward along I-5 to its intersection with Interstate 580. The service area boundary then extends westward along the northern Stanislaus County line to the County's northwestern corner-the point of beginning.
