ALTON SOUTH CONSERVATION BANK

California Tiger Salamander

The 8.11-acre Alton South Conservation Bank ("ASCB") consists of 5.11 acres of undisturbed habitat, 2.81 acres of disturbed lands of which 0.78 acre will consist of seasonal wetland habitat, and 0.19 acre of hardscape associated with Piner Road. A maximum of 7.14 acres of CTS credits will be available and, based on the format agreed upon with the USFWS and CDFG, will be released according to the following schedule, immediately upon completion of fee title transfer to the California Department of Fish and Game and the endowment is funded fully. The 0.78 acre of constructed seasonal wetland/plant establishment habitat will be used to offset effects of another project independent of this Conservation Bank.
