Subject: Permission for Access, Byron Conservation Bank, Contra Costa County

You and your staff are hereby given permission to access the Byron Conservation Bank to conduct a pedestrian surface survey for cultural resources. Please have a copy of this letter in possession while at the site. The property may be accessed by vehicle only at the entrance gate for the warehouse, and otherwise is limited to access by foot, as needed. All gates must be closed after entry, including cattle gates. Access to the property shall be limited to activities related to the pedestrian surface survey for cultural resources. This letter only authorizes access to the site to observe resources and does not authorize handling any wildlife; authorization for such activities would require other, previously acquired approval in accordance with State and Federal laws and regulations. Camping and/or other overnight stays on the property are prohibited.

This letter of permission will expire November 30, 2009.
