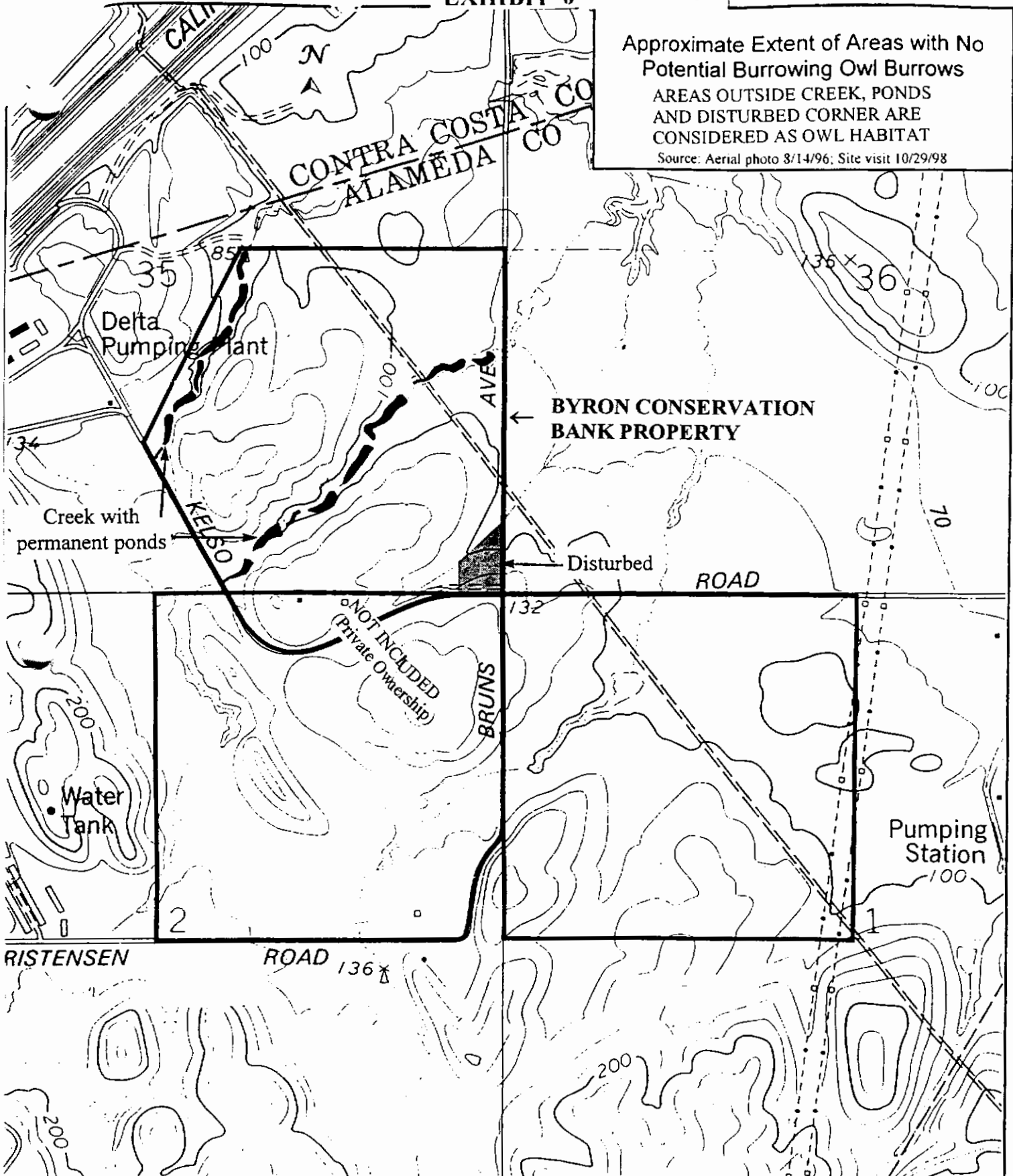


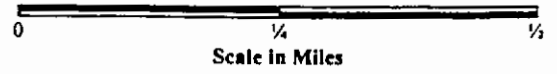

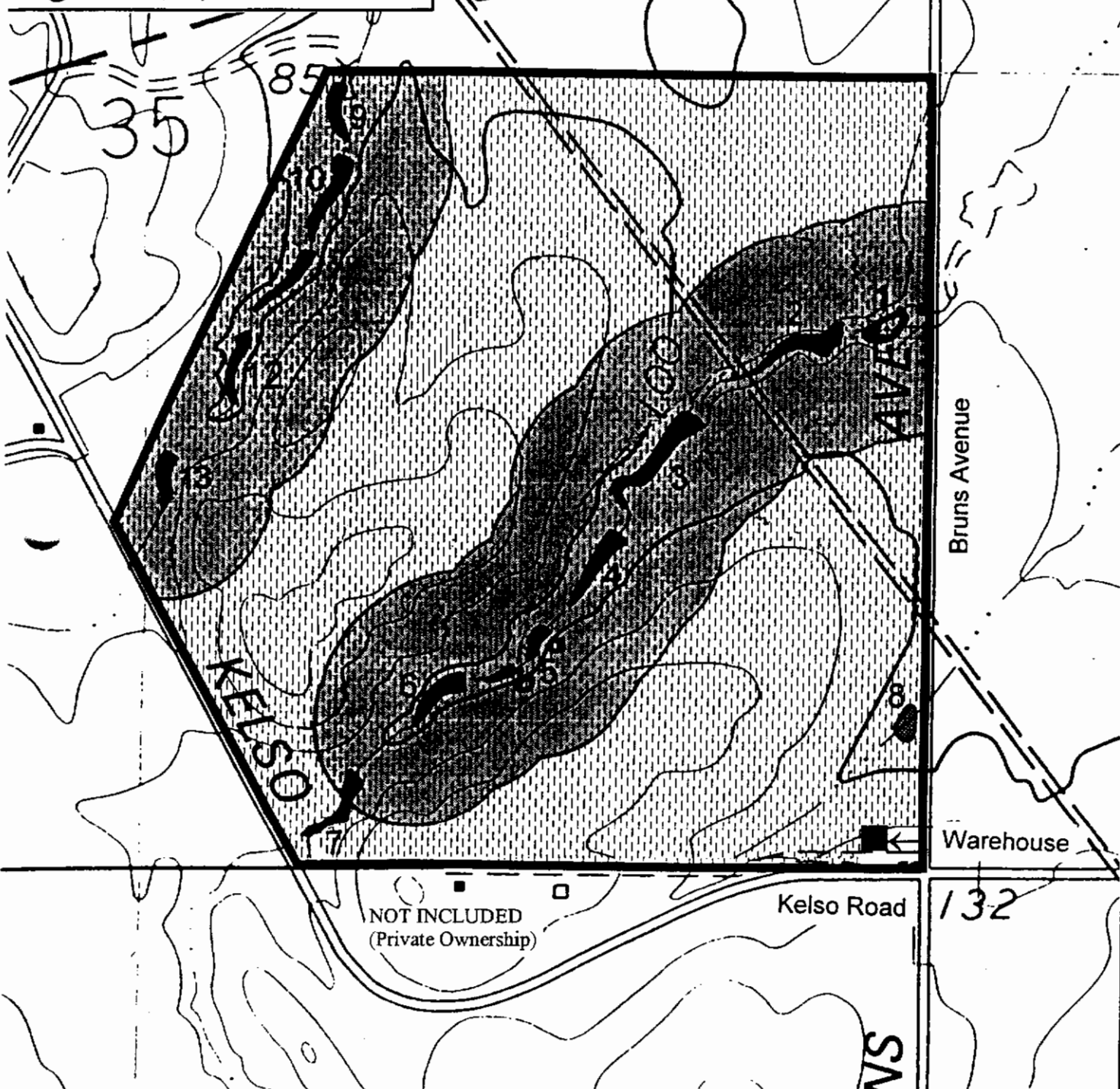


Figure 2. Red-legged Frog, Tiger Salamander & Pond Turtle - Potential Habitat
