



15-DAY NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND ADDITION OF DOCUMENTS RELIED UPON

May 22, 2018

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), 11346.8(d), 11347.1, and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, Office of Spill Prevention and Response (OSPR), is providing this notice of proposed amendments, as well as the addition of documents and other information, to the following sections of Title 14, California Code of Regulations:

- General Definitions & Abbreviations (§790);
- Certificates of Financial Responsibility (§§791 – 798)
- Oil Spill Contingency Plans for Inland Facilities (§817.04)
- Ratings for Oil Spill Response Organizations (§§819 – 819.07)
- Drills and Exercises for Inland Facilities (§820.02)

The Notices of Proposed Rulemaking were published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on December 29, 2017, Register 2017, No. 52-Z. These changes are in response to comments received during the 45-day comment period.

Attached are the proposed modified regulatory text with the changes illustrated by double strikeout for deletions, and bold and double underline for additions.
