

Instructions: TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY. Incomplete reports will be returned and could delay the issuance of your permit. Contact the License and Revenue Branch at (916) 928-5853 or SPU@wildlife.ca.gov if you need additional information regarding the Commercial Native Rattlesnake Permit records.

- 1. Complete the record in full including first name, middle initial, last name, GO ID#, permit #, and permit year.
- 2. Enter the date, scientific name and number of native rattlesnakes that were purchased, propagated, transferred, exchanged, died, total possessed and the recipients or sellers name.

 NOTE: "Total Possessed" is the complete inventory of each species per facility.
- 3. Check the appropriate box if you are no longer doing the activities which require renewal of the permit, are submitting a "zero" record that not house native rattlesnakes. IMPORTANT! If you are no longer doing the activities which require renewal of the permit, or are submitting a "zero" you are still required to submit final reports by December 31, each year within 30 days of the business closing.
- 4. Sign and date the record.
- 5. Mail the record to the Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, 1740 N. Market Blvd., Sacramento, CA \$82.
