

Harrington Farms - Santa Barbara County Fall 2021

Harrington Farms is 785 acres of farmland and rolling hills consisting of oak savannahs and juniper-sage woodlands approximately 5.9 miles south of the intersection of Hwy 166 and Hwy 33 in Santa Barbara County.

- a) **D13 Deer hunts:** 2 hunt periods (Each hunt is from Friday afternoon to Sunday afternoon)
Only one buck deer may be taken by each party.

Hunters must have a D13, D11, D15 or an Archery Only deer tag.

- Period 1 – General: **Oct 22-24 (application deadline is Oct 5)**
- Period 2 - General: **Nov 5-7 (application deadline is Oct 20)**

- b) **Quail hunts:** 1 hunt period (The hunt consists of 1 day)

- Period 1: **Oct 16 (application deadline is Sept 30)**

- c) **Dove hunt:** (The hunt consists of 1 day)

3 Access Permits will be drawn for this hunt

- Period 1: **Sept 1 (application deadline is Aug 28)**

Property Rules:

- 1 permit will be drawn for deer and quail.
- 3 permits will be drawn for dove.
- Successful applicants can bring 1 hunting partner or 1 non-hunting partner.
- Tent or trailer camping allowed in designated area but no campfires.
- No drugs or alcohol allowed.
- The hunts are not guided but the landowner will be available to answer questions.
- The landowner will drive you to the hunting area.
- Only NON-LEAD ammo must be used.
