

Dye Creek Preserve– Wild Pig Hunts

Dye Creek Preserve is 37,540 acres of blue oak woodlands, volcanic buttes, and rolling wildflower fields located in Tehama County halfway between Redding and Chico just east of I-5.

These are premium hunt opportunities provided by Western Wildlife Adventures.

Hunt Information:

- Each hunt consists of ½ day, full day, and ½ day.
- Each hunt includes:
 - Guide services
 - All food
 - 2 nights lodging
 - Transportation
- One permit will be drawn for each hunt period.
- Each successful applicant will be permitted to bring one hunter.
- Only non-lead ammo will be allowed.

Period 1: **February 1-3** (the application deadline is January 15)

Period 2: **March 5-7** (the application deadline is February 17)
