

Sierra Valley Preserve– Waterfowl Hunts

Sierra Valley Preserve is 2,500 acres of high desert meadow with seasonal wetlands located in Plumas County approximately 1 hour north of Truckee. Hunters will have access to 500 acres of the preserve.

Hunt Information:

- Each hunt consists of 2 days, Saturday and Sunday.
- A mandatory orientation will be conducted on the Friday before your hunt.
- One permit will be drawn for each hunt period.
- Each successful applicant will be permitted to bring one hunting partner.
- Only non-lead ammo will be allowed.
- One dog will be allowed per hunter.
- Hunt area is walk-in only, **no blinds**.

Period 1: **November 17-18** (the application deadline is October 31)

Period 2: **December 8-9** (the application deadline is November 21)

Period 3: **December 22-23** (the application deadline is December 5)

Period 4: **January 5-6** (the application deadline is December 19)

Period 5: **January 19-20** (the application deadline is January 2)
