

Details of Engineering-Geological Review Scoring Criteria for the 2019 Proposition 1 and Proposition 68 PSN

Applications reviewed by CDFW Engineering staff will be evaluated as follows:

A score of 0 will be assigned if the information provided was insufficient to determine that either:

- the existing site conditions have been, or are proposed to be, adequately characterized;
- the proposed project is technically appropriate for the site; or
- the project team is qualified, appropriately experienced, and has a high likelihood of successfully completing the project.

A score of 1 will be assigned if the information provided was sufficient to determine that:

- the existing site conditions have been, or are proposed to be, adequately characterized;
- the proposed project is technically appropriate for the site; and
- the project team is qualified, appropriately experienced, and has a high likelihood of successfully completing the project.

But the information provided was insufficient to determine that either:

- the proposed scope of work is appropriate and consistent with the proposed budget; or
- the proposed benefits have a high likelihood of being achieved through successful completion of the project.

A score of 2 will be assigned if the information provide was sufficient to determine that:

- the existing site conditions have been, or are proposed to be, adequately characterized;
- the proposed project is technically appropriate for the site;
- the project team is qualified, appropriately experienced, and has a high likelihood of successfully completing the project;
- the proposed scope of work is appropriate and consistent with the proposed budget;
and
- the proposed benefits have a high likelihood of being achieved through successful completion of the project.
