Regulatory Language

Section 632, Title 14, CCR, is amended to read:

§ 632. Marine Protected Areas (MPAs), Marine Managed Areas (MMAs), and Special Closures.

[No changes to current regulatory text in subsections 632(a) through (b)(16)]

- (17) Repealed: Rockport Rocks Special Closure. Special restrictions on boating and access apply to Rockport Rocks as follows.
- (A) A special closure is designated from the mean high tide line to a distance of 300 feet seaward of the mean lower low tide line of any shoreline of Rockport Rocks, located in the vicinity of 39°-44.184 'N. lat. 123°-50.020 'W. long. during the period of March 1 to August 31.
- (B) Except as permitted by federal law or emergency caused by hazardous weather, or as authorized by subsection 632(b)(17)(C), no vessel shall be operated or anchored from the mean high tide line to a distance of 300 feet seaward of the mean lower low tide line of any shoreline of Rockport Rocks during the period of March 1 to August 31. (C) No person except department employees or employees of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, or United States Coast Guard, in performing their official duties, or unless permission is granted by the department, shall enter the area defined in subsection 632(b)(17)(B) during the period of March 1 to August 31.
