
Chronic Wasting Disease Sampling Protocol



California Department of Fish and Wildlife

1. Fill out data card.

- Please record the hunter's last name and document # from the deer tag (D- 0000000000-0).
 - Place the card in the outer pocket of the sample bag, or attached to the ear if you are only collecting the head.
- If you do not have a sample bag, a Ziploc bag can be used with the name and document number written on the exterior in permanent marker.
- 2. Collect Retropharyngeal Lymph Nodes (RPLN) For a trained individual this process can take less than a minute
 - Lymph nodes are located at the base of the skull. A cut can be made just behind the angle of the jaw through the trachea and esophagus.
 - The RPLNs should be located at the 5 and 7 o'clock position relative to the windpipe, RPLNs are oval to kidney in shape, between the size of a dime and a quarter, and firm in texture.
 - Harvested RPLNs can be placed in the sample bag provided along with the data card, and can be frozen until submission to CDFW.

3. Head collection for later sampling

• If you are unable to collect the lymph nodes, CDFW asks that you remove the head along with the topmost portion of the neck and attach a data card to the head with tape or zip tie. The head can then be frozen until collection by CDFW.

4. Sample Submission
