Permit worksheet must be received with permit fee at the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch or if mailed, postmarked on or before March 31 in the case of new permit applications, or April 30 in the case of permit renewals, except for the 2020 license year. For the 2020 license year, applications for renewal of herring permits must be received by the department, or if mailed, postmarked no later than May 31, 2020. Renewals received, or post marked after these deadlines, must be accompanied with permit fee and late fee.

Instructions: Complete and return this worksheet along with your herring permit application and fees for all required licenses. Commercial fishing licensing requirements are printed in the Digest of California Commercial Fish Laws and Licensing Requirements at www.wildlife.ca.gov.
