# **CDFW Will Continue Teleworking**

The number of COVID cases in California is growing at an increasing rate. CDFW is not implementing a large-scale return to work at this time, and current plans are to maintain telework for most staff. The Department is working on COVID-19 prevention plans for facilities and other worksites, based on recent guidance, to make worksites as safe as possible for those staff currently reporting to different worksites, as well as into the future. When staff return to the office, the transition will be gradual, with at least 75% of those currently teleworking continuing to telework. Restrictions on non-essential travel remain in place.

#### **Use of Masks in CDFW Facilities**

Since Governor Newsom's June 18 order to wear face coverings, or masks, in public, the Task Force has received several questions regarding face covering use in state facilities. The COVID-19 prevention plans will provide protocols for situations and locations where masks should be worn in state facilities.

It is critical that we all abide by mask requirements, both when at work and outside of work.
