On July 13, 2020 Governor Newsom <u>implemented new orders</u> to address rising COVID-19 cases throughout the state. Effective immediately, California has closed some indoor business operations statewide. Statewide indoor closures include restaurants, bars and breweries, wineries and tasting rooms, movie theaters, family entertainment centers, zoos and museums, and cardrooms.

Additionally, the state is closing more indoor operations in those counties that have been on the Monitoring List for 3 consecutive days. County indoor closures include fitness centers, places of worship, indoor protests, offices for non-critical infrastructure sectors, personal care services, hair salons and barbershops, and malls.
