The goals of this tour are to educate the AC regarding the current conditions of the Parkway and to show current and potential natural and community investment sites. The tour will feature four sites along the middle stretch of the Parkway, from River Bend Park downstream to the Woodlake Area.

The American River Parkway includes those portions of the area between the Nimbus Dam and the confluence of the American River and the Sacramento River described in the 2008 American River Parkway Plan.
