

Crestridge Ecological Reserve



RESERVE RULES:

- **Open dawn to dusk daily.** No riding or hiking after dark.
- Hikers, dog walkers, mountain bikers, and equestrians welcome.
- **Dogs must be on leash at all times.** Please clean up after your friend.
- Stay on the trail. Use open trails only. Please avoid trails not shown on this map to protect and preserve habitat. Do not cut switchbacks.
- Do not use trails in the rain or when trails are wet. Please wait a couple days after heavy rains to use the trails. If you are leaving ruts, footprints or hoof prints please enjoy the Reserve another day.
- Do not alter trails. Bikers, please do not skid.
- Share the trails. If you see a horse and rider slow or stop and ask the rider how you should proceed. In general, downhill users yield to uphill users.
- Leave no trace. Please don't litter.
- **No motor vehicles.**
- No collecting, hunting, trapping, or firearms.
- Respect others and enjoy nature.

PARKING AND ACCESS:

(H) Horsemill Road is the main entrance with plenty of parking, restrooms, drinking water, and our Visitor Center.

Always park with consideration for our neighbors. Please don't park in the turnout near the gate.

- Vehicle parking available.
- Equestrian entry. Horse trailer parking available on street. Other limited access entry points available.

Water is available on the south leg of the Kid's Loop Trail and on Horned Lizard Bypass near the office.
