The Committee represents a diverse range of fishing and hunting interests, non-profit conservation organizations, landowners, scientific and educational interests, and others dedicated to habitat conservation and the use and protection of public trust resources.

PUBLIC COMMENT

The Committee follows the noticing requirements of the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act and will include opportunities for public comment. Comments during the public comment period shall be limited to matters within the scope of the SBB project.
