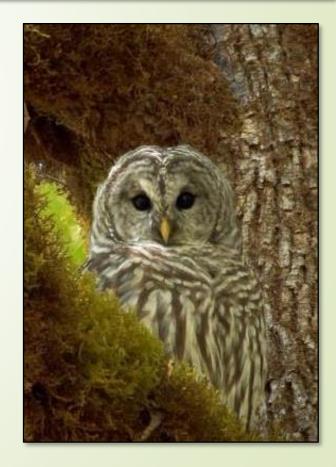

- Recovery Action 29: Design and implement large-scale control experiments to assess the effects of barred owl removal on spotted owl site occupancy, reproduction, and survival.
- Recovery Action 30: Manage to reduce the negative effects of barred owls on spotted owls.

Revised Recovery Plan for the Northern Spotted Owl

(Strix occidentalis caurina)



- Two step process
  - Define our approach to the Management Strategy
  - Develop the Management Strategy

- Decision document (USFWS)
- Range of NSO and CSO
- All lands (Federal and non-federal)
- Variable approaches in space and time

- Variable approaches in space and time
  Could include one or all of the following
  - Mapped specific locations for removal
  - Mapped landscape areas
  - Rules for selecting areas
  - Recommendations for selecting areas

- Convened teams to begin the process.
- Federal, State, and Tribal representatives.
- Gathering information and developing a working process to begin the work.

effective management of the invasive barred owl can be efficiently implemented to reduce threats to the northern and California spotted owl and contribute to their survival and recovery into the future.

- Teams will
  - Consider all approaches to barred owl management, not just removal
  - Conduct robust public outreach
  - Provide options to management, complete with analyses
  - Conduct NEPA and other compliance work

## Barred Owl Management Strategy Very Draft Timeline

- October/November 2020 Core Development Team, Coordination Team, and Compliance subteam convene
- March/April 2021 Develop general approaches for Strategy. Determine potential level compliance work required. Begin outreach.
- October 2021 Complete draft Strategy, draft NEPA and other draft compliance documents. Public Outreach.
- March 2022 Complete development of Strategy and compliance, including NEPA.
- June 2022 Decision on Strategy, finalization of documentation, work on implementation.
