The Department has proposed a regulation change that would extend the timeline for people who already indicated a willingness to participate to finish their participation. It would give them 1 year from the date they were notified of eligibility, or January 31, 2024 whichever comes first.  If the new proposed regulation passes, permittees will have 1 year from the date you were notified to complete the process. If, however, the new proposed regulation does not pass, they must still complete the process by March 31, 2021.
