

EPIMS Permitting Portal



The Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has a new Environmental Permit Information Management System (EPIMS). EPIMS Permitting Portal enables applicants to complete a Lake and Streambed Alteration (LSA) notification and submit online. Notifications submitted through the portal allow for a paperless permit process by facilitating uploads of supplemental documentation (i.e., plans, diagrams, maps, photos, studies), calculation of permit fees, electronic signatures, email alerts, and applicant tracking of permit progress.
