



## LIVESTOCK LOSS DETERMINATION

**Investigation ID:** 111721-SIS

**Date Investigated:** 11/17/21

**Cause of Death:**

- Confirmed Wolf
- Probable Wolf
- Possible Wolf
- Non-Wolf Depredation
- Non-Depredation
- Unknown

**General Area:** Southern Siskiyou County, private property

**General situation and animal information:** On November 17, a rancher found the fresh carcass of a 200-pound calf and suspected possible depredation because dispersing wolf OR103 had recently been in the vicinity. CDFW and Siskiyou County personnel were notified and investigated that day.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** No evidence of predation was found.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury:** There was no evidence of wolf presence near the time of death.

**Summary:** While the abdominal cavity had been scavenged, the carcass was otherwise intact. There were no bite marks on the carcass. The lungs were filled with bloody fluid, consistent with pneumonia.
