Bay-Delta Sport Fishing Enhancement Stamp Advisory Committee Member Solicitation

Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the Bay-Delta Sport Fishing Enhancement Stamp Advisory Committee.

Applications must be submitted by June 11, 2010.

The Bay-Delta Sport Fishing Enhancement Stamp Advisory Committee consists of 9-members who each serve a 4-year term at the discretion of the Department of Fish and Game (Department) Director. Stamp legislation specifies appointed persons should possess experience in subjects of specific value to the committee and appointed persons shall be able to balance the interests of a variety of angling constituencies.

The role of the Advisory Committee is to recommend projects and budgets for the expenditure of revenue generated by the stamp. Funds are to be used for the long-term, sustainable benefit of the primary Bay-Delta sport fisheries including, but not limited to, striped bass, sturgeon, black bass, halibut, salmon, surf perch, steelhead trout, and American shad. Funds shall be expended to benefit sport fish populations, sport fishing opportunities, and anglers within the stamp's geographic range.

Each member that serves on the Advisory Committee must be able to represent specific fisheries and geographic areas while balancing the interests of multiple constituents. Committee members should plan to attend (in person) approximately two meetings per year and commit to approximately one additional day per meeting to review documents, projects, and additional meeting preparation. All committee members will be required to act in a professional and courteous manner.
