Background



Revenue And Taxation Code Section 34019(f)(2):

- Focus on the clean up, remediation, restoration of environmental damage in watersheds affected by cannabis cultivation and related activities
- Department may allocate funds for this purpose through a grant program

Public Land Cleanup and Remediation Solicitation - Funding Priority



Priority:

Cleanup and Remediation of Illicit Cannabis Cultivation Impacts on Qualified Public Land

Qualified Public Land:

Land owned in fee simple title and managed by a federal, state, local government, or institution, or California Native American tribal government. It also includes land held by the United States in trust for a California Native American tribe.



Public Land Cleanup and Remediation Solicitation – Project Type



Project Type: Cleanup and Remediation

- Reduce delivery of contaminants and waste to the environment
- Remove refuse and infrastructure
- Cleanup and remediate aquatic, riparian, and/or upland native species habitat
- Minimize risk of fish, wildlife, and human exposure to toxic materials





Public Land Cleanup and Remediation Solicitation - Project Category



Project Category: Cleanup and Remediation

- Categorically exempt CEQA and categorically excluded NEPA activities
- Eligible activities:
 - Finalizing site selection
 - Submitting a Notice of Exemption and/or Categorical Exclusion
 - Acquiring permits
 - Hazardous material testing and disposal
 - Infrastructure removal
 - Training and capacity building to increase cleanup efforts

Watershed Enhancement Solicitation - Funding Priority



Priority: Enhance Watersheds and Communities

- Restore or enhance aquatic, riparian, and/or upland native species habitat or habitat connectivity.
- Protect aquatic, riparian, and/or upland native species.
- Alleviate a limiting factor within the watershed.

Watershed Enhancement Solicitation - Project Categories



Planning

- Provide funding for activities that will lead to a specific on-the-ground implementation projects.

Cleanup and Remediation

- Categorically exempt CEQA and categorically excluded NEPA activities, which result in the cleanup and remediation of environmental damage on private land in watersheds affected by cannabis cultivation.

Implementation

- Fund construction and monitoring of shovel-ready restoration and enhancement projects. Applicants must demonstrate CEQA compliance, and submit 65% or higher design plans.

WebGrants – Recommendations



- Save your progress often
- Start your application early
- Use the WebGrants “Back” button to navigate
- Work offline with the Word version of the App before completing the WebGrants version
- Attachment file names must be brief and include the application number

Tips for Writing Proposals

Read Solicitation and Application instructions carefully

Clearly address the criteria outlined in the Solicitation

- Make a clear tie between your project and the Solicitation Priorities

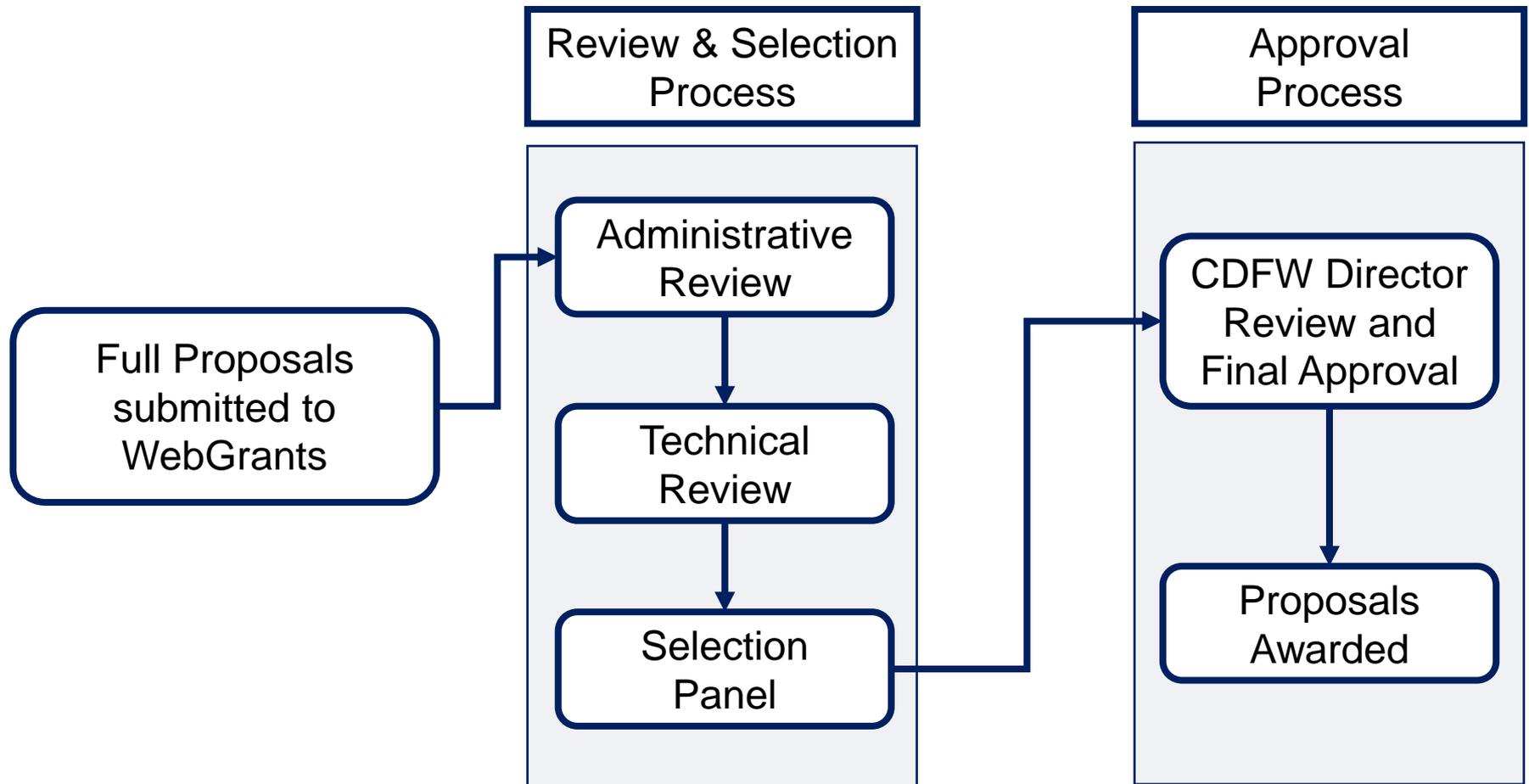
Connect the dots

- Make sure all the required information connects together
- The proposed work should justify the requested grant amount

Clearly describe the proposed project

- Who? – Project Team and Landowners
- What? – Scope of Work and Expected Benefits
- When? – Schedule and Work Windows
- Where? – Project Location and Site Information
- Why? – Purpose and Need
- How? – Materials, Methods, and Plans
